The partners have researched existing methods and techniques in the field of workplace innovation, and integrated and refined them for the purpose of creating the new WIN Manager profile.

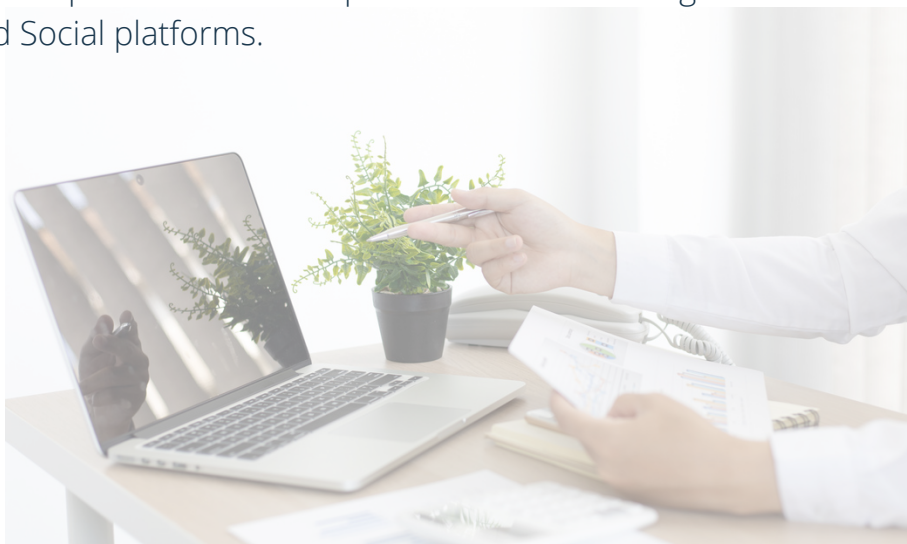
